What is CHIP/Children's Medicaid?

Children's Medicaid offers free health and medical services to the children of families that qualify.

CHIP (Children's Health Insurance Program) is for children of families that earn too much to qualify for Medicaid but cannot afford private health insurance. Families pay based on their income. Some families pay nothing for their children's health and medical services. Other families may pay up to \$50 a year for all their children. Some families may also have to pay co-payments of \$3 to \$5 dollars for some services.

What services do children get?

Both CHIP and Children's Medicaid offer many services including regular checkups, immunizations, prescription drugs, dental visits, cleanings and fillings, eye exams and glasses.

How can I get it for my children?

Your children may qualify based on your family's income and other factors. Visit us on the date and time listed above. You can pick up a CHIP/Children's Medicaid application and get answers to your questions.

What information should I bring:

- Your child's Social Security number.
- Child's Alien Registration Card (I-551) or a copy of the front and back of the card if your child is not a U.S citizen.
- Proof of each family member's income, such as most recent paycheck stub, a letter from an employer stating how much is earned, or papers that show how much is being received in child support.
- Proof of how much your family pays for childcare, disabled adult care, or child support.
