CITY OR COUNTY NAME) families with uninsured children may be eligible for health coverage through the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) or Children's Medicaid. Both programs provide a wide range of health care benefits to keep kids healthy.

Bring along the information requested at the right, as it will help determine whether your family qualifies for either CHIP or Children's Medicaid. Families that qualify will pay no more than \$50 a year for CHIP coverage and those that qualify for Children's Medicaid will pay nothing for six months of coverage. Benefits include choice of doctors, regular check-ups, prescription drugs, dental services, shots, and eye exams and glasses.

Information to bring:

- **Your child's Social Security number.**
- **If your child is not a U.S. citizen, you will need to bring the child's Alien Registration Card (I-551) or a copy of the front and back of the card.**
- **Proof of income for each member of your family, such as each person's most recent paycheck stub, a letter from the person's employer stating how much the family member is paid, or papers that show how much the family member is receiving in child support.**
- **Proof of how much you pay for childcare, disabled adult care, or child support.**
